Water playfully dances down these pure copper links and cups to create a captivating and relaxing atmosphere. Rainwater can even be collected and used effectively in the garden. Copper Rain Chains will age gracefully over time to a charming blue-green patina.

DOUBLE RAIN CHAIN Assembly Instructions

THE RAIN CHAIN IS 3 FEET LONG & CONSISTS OF 7 DOUBLE RINGS.

AT EACH END OF THE CHAIN, THERE IS A RING THAT IS SPLIT TO OPEN AND ONE THAT IS SOLID.

WHEN CONNECTING A 3 FOOT RAIN CHAIN TO ANOTHER 3 FOOT RAIN CHAIN, SIMPLY:
